PSC: Report 1st Quarter 2015

Comparison 1st Quarter 2015 with previous years

Below graph shows that the total number of inspections during the first quarter has decreased from **50** in 2013 to **29** in 2015.

The number of deficiencies shows that the deficiencies have decreased from **50** to **37**. However, PSC visits with observations have increased from **9** to **14**.

The number of ISM observations which count as 5 observations is back on 3 observations 1^{st} Quarter 2015, compared to 1 in 2014. In 2013 there were 2 detentions.

2014 was a good year with no detentions, but unfortunately there was 1 detention 1st Quarter 2015.

In 2014 we had an EF at -0.89 and at the threshold to 2015 we had an EF at -0,70. The EF increased due to a detention in the beginning of 2015. Prior to the detention the EF was -0,79 and afterwards -0,54.

Since this detention the EF has increased to -0,69 1st Quarter 2015.
