Executive order No. 89 of 18 June 2013 on confidentiality in connection with the Faroese Maritime Authority's handling of complaints about working and living conditions on board ships

Under the provisions in section 18 subsection 4 in Act No. 165 from 21 December 2001 on safety at Sea, as amended by Act No. 61 from 17 May 2013, the following shall be laid down:

Section 1. Complaints about working and living conditions on board according to the MLC, received by the Faroese Maritime Authority from seafarers or their organisations, shall be considered confidential. The Faroese Maritime Authority shall not inform the shipowner or the employer or their representatives that an inspection on board the ship concerned is due to such a complaint.

Subsection 2. The Faroese Maritime Authority shall not, in connection with the consideration of a complaint received from a crewmember, inform the shipowner or his representative who has filed the complaint.

Section 2. This executive order shall enter into force on 20 August 2013.
