Executive order No. 136 of 11 August 2025 on fees for measurement of ships

Under the provisions in section 9 subsection 1 in Parliamentary Act No. 90 of 10 June 1982 on measurement of ships, the following shall be laid down:

Section 1. For the issuance of an international tonnage certificate following measurement pursuant to section 3 subsection 1, of the Parliamentary Act, the Faroese Maritime Authority shall charge a fee of DKK 2 for each gross tonnage to which the vessel has been measured, however, as a minimum a fee of DKK 645.

Section2. For the issuance of a new international tonnage certificate or for corrections to an international tonnage certificate, the Faroese Maritime Authority shall charge a fee of DKK 1 for each gross tonnage to which the vessel has been measured, however, as a minimum a fee of DKK 645.

Section 3. For the issuance of an international tonnage certificate to a vessel purchased abroad, which already holds a valid international tonnage certificate at the time of acquisition, the Faroese Maritime Authority shall charge a fee of DKK 2 for each gross tonnage to which the vessel has been measured, however, as a minimum a fee of DKK 645.

Section 4. For all other tonnage certificates or tonnage attestations, including for vessels under 24 metres in length, the Faroese Maritime Authority shall charge a fee of DKK 645.

Subsection 2. For all copies of tonnage certificates or tonnage attestations, the Faroese Maritime Authority shall charge a fee of DKK 645.

Section 5. For the issuance of a new tonnage certificate or tonnage attestation, or for corrections in a tonnage certificate or tonnage attestation, pursuant to section 4, the Faroese Maritime Authority shall charge a fee of DKK 645.

Section 6. Fractions of a ton shall not be taken into account when calculating fees under this Executive Order.

Section 7. The obligation to pay fees rests with the shipowner.

Section 8. This executive order comes into force the day after it has been promulgated. At the same Executive Order No.91 of 21 September 1989 on fees for measurement of ships is made void.
